Enrollment Procedures

- Read & understand all information provided in this form and in the brochure. Decide on the program you wish to study and the date you wish to start.
- Fax, mail, e-mail or courier your completed Enrolment Form to IH San Diego or an authorized IH San Diego agent in your home country. You can also register on-line at: www.ihsandiego.com.
- Check U.S. visa requirements at <http://travel.state.gov>
- Make your payment. Your non-refundable registration and placement fees are due at the time of registration with the balance due at least 21 days prior to the start of your course. Acceptable forms of payment include: Bank transfer, bank draft, money order, traveler's cheque, VISA, Mastercard or cash
- Once your enrollment form and payment have been received, we will send you your Letter of Acceptance and Receipt of Payment.
- Arrive at school on your chosen start date no later than 8:45 for registration, placement testing, and orientation.

Refund & Cancellation Policies

1. Non-Refundable Fees

The registration fee and homestay placement fee are non-refundable.

2. Absence & Postponement

Students wishing to postpone their studies or take time off may do so with a two-week prior written notice. A \$100 fee will be applied for the second such request.

3. Cancellation Before Course Begins

If written notice of cancellation is received prior to (7) days before the first day of a course, tuition fees will be refunded in full.

If written notice of cancellation is received (7) days or less before the start of the course, tuition fees less \$250 will be refunded.

4. Programs of study may not be downgraded once they have commenced.

5. Withdrawal After Course Begins

There are no refunds for courses of 4 weeks or less.

For courses longer than 4 weeks, if the student has completed 50% or less of the course at the time of withdrawal from classes and provides written notice of withdrawal, the first 4 weeks of the course are non-refundable. Additional weeks will be refunded on a prorated basis, and are calculated from the last day of attendance (any part of a week attended is considered a full week for refund calculations).

6. Applying through an IH San Diego Representative

Students who enroll through a representative office must obtain their refund directly from the representative and comply with the representative's refund policies.
